CalFresh is a nutrition assistance program sponsored by the USDA that issues a monthly allotment on an Electronic Benefit Transfer (EBT card) that you can use at most grocery stores and farmers markets.

The EBT card can be used at:

- Local grocery stores
- Online stores
- Farmer's markets
- Restaurant meal program (if applicable)

Are you eligible?

General Eligibilities:

- 1 Must be U.S. citizen, Legal Permanent Resident (LPR), or have someone in their household who is able to apply for CalFresh.
- 2 Monthly income must not exceed the allowed amount.
- 3 Students must meet **ONE** of the student eligibilities.
